

How to Book

You can book an accommodation with us in four steps:

STEP 1: Search

To make a reservation for one of our accommodations you search first our portfolio for availability of accommodations. This is simply done with the search menu above. The site shows you the available accommodations that meet your requirements. Select your desired holiday home and then press the button RESERVE NOW. STEP 2: Reservation

On the reservation form you check the details of the accommodation and enter your personal details. Please don't forget to read carefully the terms and conditions before continuing with the reservation. Once you have finished filling in the data, you can proceed to the next page. STEP 3: Payment

After reception of this reservation by our reservation department your desired accommodation will be reserved on behalf of you. If the holiday home is not available anymore during the given period we will contact you with an alternative. This alternative should be confirmed by you first in order to settle the reservation. You will then receive a confirmation and a request to settle the first payment. The reservation is to be confirmed definitely after reception of this first payment which is 40% of total amount (for European citizens only). Payment method is by bank transfer to our bank account in the Netherlands. Final payment should be settled no less than 6 weeks before your arrival in the holiday home. You will then receive the vouchers and itineraries after the receipt of this final payment. If a reservation is placed 6 weeks or less before arrival, you will be requested to settle the total payment at ones. Reservations from non-EU residents need to be settled totally before any confirmation can be made. STEP 4: Confirmation Once we have received the total payment, you will receive the confirmation via e-mail. The days are then reserved for you. The confirmation includes all information regarding your holiday home. The responsible of the accommodation will receive at the same time a copy of the confirmation so that he/she can prepare for your arrival and stay.
